EXECUTIVE PROCLAMATION**

OKLAHOMA SECRETARY
OF STATE

I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 8-122 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes, hereby order, pursuant to the findings entered by the Honorable Paula Inge, District Judge of the Twenty-Fifth Judicial District of Oklahoma, stating that 5 votes were illegally cast in the Democratic Runoff Primary Election for Coal County Commissioner District 2, held on August 23, 2016. After a hearing was conducted, the Court could not determine a successful candidate and deemed it impossible to determine to whom a certificate of election should be issued. Accordingly, a new Democratic Runoff Primary Election involving the identical candidates must be set.

The Special Democratic Runoff Primary Election shall be held on February 14, 2017.

The Secretary of the State Election Board and the Secretary of the Coal County election board are hereby directed to take all actions necessary to conduct this election. Copies of this Executive Proclamation shall be distributed accordingly.
