An Act relating to the University Hospitals Authority; providing for duties and compensation of employees; requiring compliance with and providing budgetary limitations; requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures; requiring transfers of certain funds; requiring certain funds be used for certain programs; providing lapse dates; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: University Hospitals Authority

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the University Hospitals Authority by law shall be set by the University Hospitals Authority.

SECTION 2. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority shall transfer the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) from the funds appropriated in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature to the University Hospitals Authority Disbursing Fund created by Section 3221 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.

SECTION 3. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority shall transfer the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from

the funds appropriated in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature to the Oklahoma Institute for Disaster and Emergency Medicine Revolving Fund established pursuant to Section 1-2523 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.

SECTION 4. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority shall transfer the sum of Six Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$625,000.00) from the funds appropriated in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature to the Dental Loan Repayment Revolving Fund established pursuant to Section 1-2714 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.

SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be used for patient care at the University of Oklahoma Wayman Tisdale Specialty Health Clinic.

SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Seven Hundred Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$712,000.00) shall be used for providing hearing services for deaf and/or hard-of-hearing children statewide.

SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be used for the purpose of enhancing the quality of Oklahoma primary care practices through Area Health Education Centers and Public Health Institute of Oklahoma programs.

SECTION 8. From the funds appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority in Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be expended for contractual outreach dental services in the State of Oklahoma provided by the Oklahoma Dental Foundation.

SECTION 9. Appropriations made by Section 68 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-

14) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15). Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

SECTION 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

SECTION 11. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.


