A Concurrent Resolution setting the date for sine die adjournment of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature.

WHEREAS, Section 26 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution requires that the regular session be finally adjourned sine die not later than the last Friday in May; and

WHEREAS, based on these parameters, the legislative calendar for the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature will end on May 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature will complete its work for the regular legislative session in a timely manner on Friday, May 24, 2013, one week prior to the date required to be finally adjourned sine die.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 30 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution, each house of the Legislature shall have the permission of the opposite house to adjourn for more than three days.

THAT the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature shall be finally adjourned sine die on May 24, 2013. The date and time of the sine die adjournment shall be so reflected in the House and Senate Journals.
