

Proclamation

Whereas, Angelman Syndrome (AS) is a rare, severe neurological disorder characterized by profound developmental delays, problems with motor coordination (ataxia) and seizures; and

Whereas, AS affects all races and both genders equally and often requires life-long care and intense therapies to assist those diagnosed; and

Whereas, treatment for individuals with AS can be difficult to manage; and

Whereas, despite these challenges, those with AS appear to have a very happy demeanor, characterized by frequent laughing, smiling, and excitability; and

Whereas, the Foundation for Angelman Syndrome Therapeutics (FAST) is an all-volunteer organization dedicated to finding a cure for AS and related disorders through the funding of research, education, and advocacy; and


