

Whereas, medical billers may offer expertise in carrier reimbursement requirements in addition to safeguarding that medical claims are accurately prepared; and


Whereas, medical billers continue to influence the billing process in a constructive and credible manner and should be recognized for their efforts on behalf of their profession;
