

Proclamation

Whereas, the Aviation Sciences program at Southeastern Oklahoma State University has an extensive and storied history; and

Whereas, Southeastern Oklahoma State University in 1966 became only the second university in the United States to offer a bachelor's degree in aviation; and

Whereas, Southeastern's Aviation Sciences program has expanded since its inception with courses now offered in Durant, at Tinker Air Force Base and Rose State College in Midwest City, and Oklahoma City Community College; and

Whereas, recently the university unveiled its Pilot Pipeline Program, an agreement Southeastern and EnvoyAir (formerly American Eagle Airlines) have in place to develop a career path from student to Regional Airline Pilot; this acclaimed program gives the pilot a secured position at Envoy, while building time toward the ATP minimum flight experience requirements; and


