Proclamation

Whereas, the Jewish Federation of Greater Oklahoma City was established in 1941 and is celebrating 75 years of bringing light to the community; and

Whereas, the Jewish Federation of Greater Oklahoma City is part of a network of more than 160 federations across our nation whose mission is to enhance and connect the Jewish community, preserve and strengthen Israel, to ensure Jewish continuity and to fulfill the responsibility of *tzedekah*, justice; and

Whereas, in order to perform *mitzvot* (good deeds) and carry out *tikkun olam* (repair of the world) in the past 25 years the Jewish Federation of Greater Oklahoma City has partnered with over 120 other nonprofit agencies, foundations and corporations in Oklahoma City with similar values to maximize resources and present programs of mutual benefit; and

Whereas, the Jewish Federation of Greater Oklahoma City supports the work of nonprofit organizations in the city by providing them with annual allocations, networking opportunities and referrals so that together they may extend their reach, do more good, and improve the community; and

Whereas, the Jewish Federation of Greater Oklahoma City has been an integral part of the fabric of our community for 75 years and it reflects compassion, kindness and a spirit of generous giving in the work it carries out every day;

Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim November 19, 2016, as

"The Jewish Federation of Greater Oklahoma City 75th Anniversary Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
