

**Whereas**, there are currently over 500,000 open computing jobs nationwide and over 2,000 computing jobs in Oklahoma alone with an average salary of \$68,598, which is significantly higher than most average salaries; and

**Whereas**, computer science occupations are the number one source of all new wages in the nation and make up two-thirds of all projected new jobs in STEM fields; and

**Whereas**, school districts in Oklahoma are encouraged to adopt broad policy framework to provide students with access to the expanding computer science industry; and

**Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor**, do hereby proclaim the week December 5, 2016, as
